

PEC Launches New SMS Alert Program

- On August 6, PEC launched one-way SMS text alerts for members and public officials
 - Alerts will provide vital information during emergencies only
 - Used for prolonged outages and ERCOT Energy Emergency Alerts
- 287,000 members received informational text message
- About 1% of members who received SMS messages have opted out — 3,826 members
- Work underway on future SMS functionality



Legislative and Regulatory Update

- 8/7/21: 2nd Special Session started
 - Energy-related issues are not on Governor's priority list
- ~300 bills filed, <10 energy-related
 - Demand-response programs (Rep. Ron Reynolds)
 - Adequate reserve power to prevent blackouts (Rep. Ron Reynolds)
 - Interconnection of transmission facilities in ERCOT with transmission facilities outside ERCOT (Rep. Ron Reynolds)
 - Creation and uses of critical infrastructure resiliency fund (Rep. Erin Zwiener)




Record Growth Continues
