SUBJECT: Engineering Master Service Agreements

We have reviewed responses to the recent Request for Qualifications for Engineering Services - Transmission, Substation, and Distribution. This RFQ provides for a selection pool of qualified consultants to complete a variety of Engineering Services on an as-needed basis. The selection of approved consultants was based on a review of qualifications, references, and previous PEC experience. There were twenty responses to the Substation/Transmission RFQ and 19 responses to the Distribution RFQ. Shown below are the consultants that were selected to perform some or all of the requested services.

The Substation/Transmission RFQ Team consisted of Christina Garza, Ryan Morlino, and Paul Lochte. The Distribution RFQ Team consisted of Christina Garza, Pedro Estrada, Alan Herring, Bradley Noack, Dirk Field, and Paul Lochte. Based on the review, we recommend that the above listed Engineering firms be approved to perform Engineering Consulting at PEC.



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We are recommending the MSA be approved for five years for \$25 million for substation and transmission services and \$50 million for distribution services. The Engineering services will be used to complete CIP budgeted projects, maintenance construction, distribution line extensions, various engineering studies and inspections. The MSA and rates will go into effect on January 1, 2020.

If you concur with the recommendation we would appreciate your assistance in securing the approval of the CEO and Board so that we may proceed with the services
