



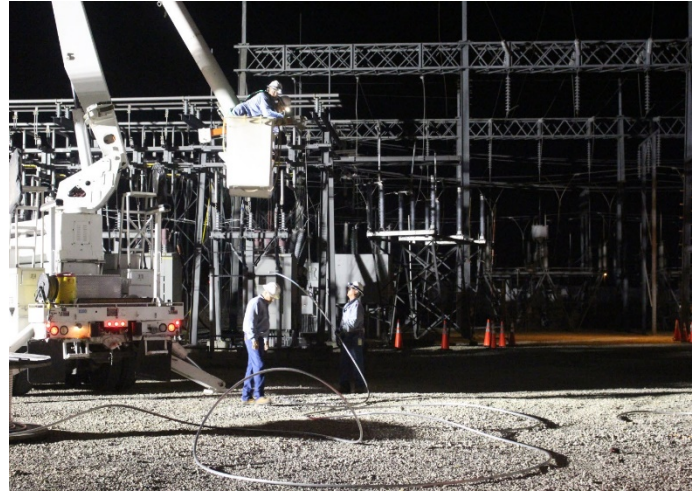

Leander Substation Upgrade



- Upgrade to 138 kV Operating Bus at Leander Substation
- Installed temporary equipment to carry the load during the outage to maintain reliable service and not cause additional congestion on the grid
- Initially tied two of the three existing transmission lines together, then ERCOT identified an issue causing significant costs to the market
- Studied reconfigurations to tie the third transmission line in with the other two, and completed work between 2:30 am and 8:00 am

Soon the lights flicker back on and the digital clocks start blinking.

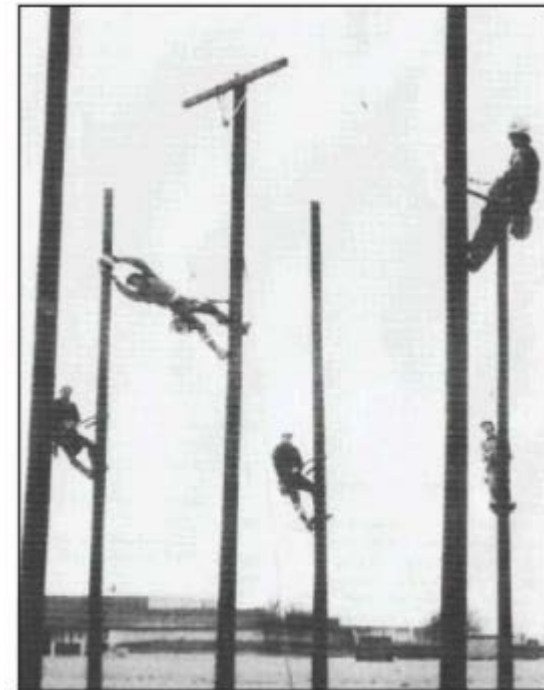
Welcome to the world of the Pedernales Electric Cooperative linemen.

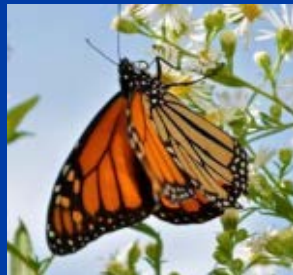
PEC Named in America's Top Co-Ops!

- PEC is proud to rank among National Cooperative Bank's top 100 co-ops in the United States for the fourth consecutive year
- Based on 2018 revenues of \$634 million, PEC was No. 87, two spots higher than last year, seven spots higher than 2017, and 11 spots higher than 2016



PEC Pollinator Habitat

- New initiative to promote pollinator habitat
- USFWS considering potential endangerment finding for the Monarch Butterfly, currently anticipated in December 2020
- Beginning with pollinator plots at District Offices
- Investigating whether some transmission line right-of-way would be appropriate
- Purchasing seed packets to give to members at certain events and will be made available at PEC offices
