

# Record Hot Peak Days!




- 23 days over 100 degrees so far this summer in Austin area
  - 16 days over 100 degrees in Johnson City



ERCOT set all time record peak  
Monday August 12<sup>th</sup>  
**74,531 MW**

Previous ERCOT record  
July 19, 2018  
**73,473 MW**

- ERCOT declared Energy Emergency Alert (EEA) level 1 for the first time since 2014 on August 13<sup>th</sup>
  - Emergency Response Service (ERS) loads were dispatched by ERCOT and were enough to stabilize the grid and avoid rotating outages
    - ~850 MW ERCOT wide
    - ~20 MW across 40 PEC members



# Record Growth in July!



District Operations overall set two records last month:

- Record number of Line Extension – 1628 (previous record was 1528)
  - Cedar Park only individual district breaking its previous record of 298 with 299
- Record number Net Meter Growth – 2517 (previous record was 1950)

# Transmission Cost of Service Update



July 30 - Public Utility Commission approved PEC's Interim Update of Wholesale Transmission Rates

- Reflects \$101.8M in rate base
- Increase of \$5.3M in revenue requirement
- New rates effective as of July 30

# First Warning Weather University (FWWU)


- Partnership with KXAN
