





Cooperative Solar Project Update And Construction Report

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Cooperative Solar Sites and Project Update

- RES has initiated construction of 15 MW of distributed solar generation for PEC
- Each project will be between 3-5 months in duration
- Commercial Operation Date 2017 and early 2018




Site Construction Timeline

- Procurement of modules, invertors and racking systems Complete
- Poles and lines moved to prevent shading August
- Construction mobilization, crews on site August – December
- Facility Testing October – February
- Interconnection to PEC distribution system November – March
- Anticipated Commercial Operations Date November – March

Cooperative Solar Rate Option Status

- Member participation workflow defined
- Supporting IT systems under construction
 - NISC billing system configured; several test runs complete
 - Topaz on-line subscription management in development
 - NISC program management reports in development
- End to end system testing begins in September
- Member sign-up starts in late November/early December
 - On-line application
 - Subscription offered on first come, first serve basis
 - Participation up to 100% of average monthly usage
 - Flexible terms with no up-front investment or contract
- Rate effective February 1st
