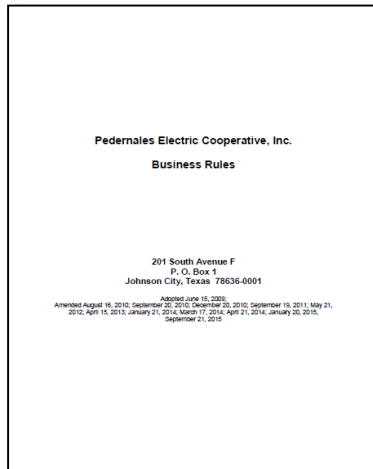

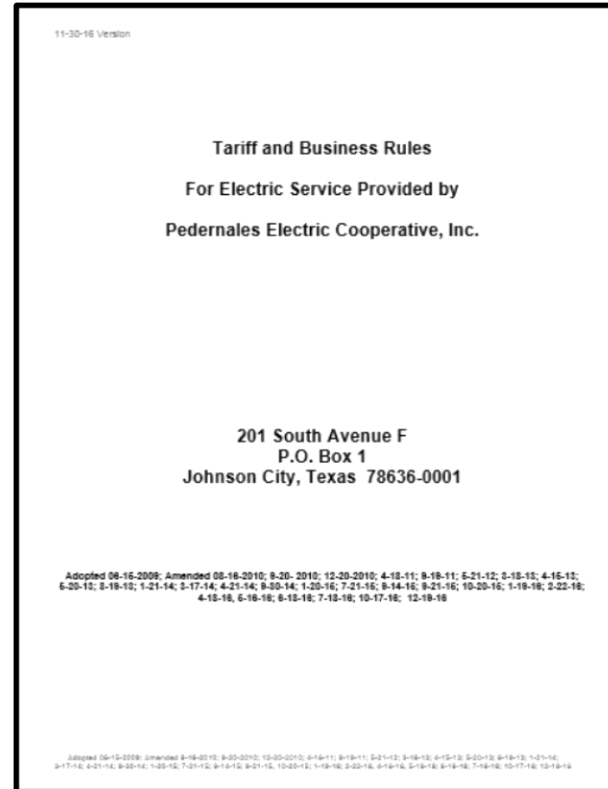
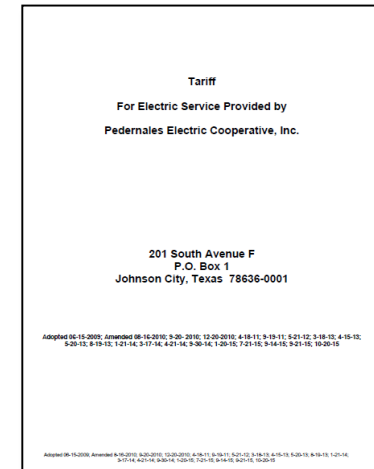

Combine the two documents to eliminate duplicates and inconsistencies, while taking into consideration current business practices and the state of operations

Business Rules and Tariff Combination Highlights

Goals: (1) increase Member access and understanding of PEC's policies; (2) simplify by eliminating duplicates and inconsistencies; and (3) consider current business practices and the state of operations

- Military Discount Rate: added per Texas' legislative requirement
- Clarifying the College Discount Rate is for non-profit institutions
- Line Extension: Completion time within 90 days of payment
- Cleared up language related to Large Power's 12 month average requirement
- Timing of service: changed to within 3 working days
- Criminal charges for tampering with meters or stealing power
- Stating PEC's preference for individual metering for residential units
- Contribution in aid of construction: applicable to commercial accounts only



Future Unresolved Items

Changes that would constitute a change to current policy, will be brought for Board approval at a later date. These are the following:

- Commercial Line Extension Policy
- Engineering design charges for non-members
- Late fees on loan payments

Additionally, we are working with Communications to further improve Member accessibility to the Tariff and Business Rules For Electric Service.
