


2017 Update of Cost of Service Study and Rate Design

Project Charter

- Update and evaluate the cost of service study to assure that PEC rates are fair and equitable across all the rate classes and designed to meet PEC financial requirements
- Perform a cost of service study that is conducted routinely according to board policy



Scope

- Financial model with forecast update
- Cost of Service update
 - o Incorporate the Rural Utility Service (RUS) model
 - o Revenue requirements
 - o Including 1 and 3 phase, line extensions, over/under ground
 - Allocation factor per Member category and evaluate the need for additional Member categories
- Rate design options development and analysis
 - o Evaluate viability and sustainability of current options
 - Consider additional rate options (Pre-pay, TCOS, interconnection, critical peak pricing, and demand charges)
- Evaluate fees and charges
- Financial model scenario analysis
