






# Cooperative Solar Rate Option Update

- **Enrollment:** Over 1,400 participating Members with capacity available (1.3 MW) for about 175 more Residential accounts
- **Wait-List:** Small Power and Large Power rate classes are fully subscribed with new applications placed on wait-list
- **Solar Production:** Ramping up with first solar array on-line at Johnson City (2 MW) on January 23<sup>rd</sup>. Additional solar sites at Junction (1MW), Bertram (4 MW) and Andice (4 MW) to come on-line during February.
- **Solar Allocation:** Rate effective February 1<sup>st</sup> with Members to receive first solar allocation on March statement
- **Rate Class Allocation:** Temporary rate class allocation for first six months following rate effective expires on August 1<sup>st</sup>



