

## Tariff Changes for Rates –

Transmission, Cooperative Solar and PEC Owned EV Stations

## Section 100.21

Applicability: Members receiving power at transmission level voltage (60 KV or above)

- Pricing:
  - Service Availability Charge: \$1,000.00 per month
  - Transmission Cost of Service: pass-through
  - Power Supply Charge: pass-through
- Reason: Requested by new Member entering our service area.
- Effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019



Cooperative Solar Rate

Sections 100.8.5 and 100.12.1

- Rate changes:
  - Solar Base Power Charge changes from \$0.05608 to \$0.06108 per kWh
  - 2. TCOS rate applies to all of Members Delivered Energy instead of only non-solar energy delivered
  - 3. New Solar Transmission Cost Adjustment credit at 80% of TCOS charge
  - 4. Removal of early agreement termination fee
  - 5. Clean up tariff language for clarity
- Reason: The initial Cooperative Solar Rate was created prior to site construction being completed. Site construction has been completed on the majority of sites and all development and program administration costs are incorporated into the updated rate.
- Program changes are effective for <u>new</u> applicants starting March 1, 2019 and for <u>all</u> Members enrolled as of February 1, 2020.



PEC Owned EV Charger Rate

## Section 100.20

- Existing rate language:
  - Pricing: \$0.03 per 30 seconds
  - Not based on actual energy transferred but time plugged in
- Proposed rate language:
  - Pricing: TOU price per KWh
  - All other costs are the same as Residential charges, except for Service Availability Charge which will be 10% of total cost to mirror our cost incurred from our billing provider.
- Reason: We have diligently been working with our billing provider to change the rate design to closely mirror our costs.
  We now have the ability to charge the TOU rate per kWh that closely mirrors our cost of power.
- Effective upon Board approval.





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
