100.11 **Cooperative Area Lighting (AL)**

Applicability -

Applicable to Cooperative owned outdoor dusk-to-dawn lighting assets where the Cooperative's existing facilities (either owned by the Cooperative or the Member) are suitable for the installation of the lighting. Cooperative owned outdoor lighting assets include lamps and lighting fixtures ("Cooperative Area Lighting").

Maintenance or Repairs of Cooperative Area Lighting

The Cooperative will own, furnish, install, and maintain lights on its existing facilities. If additional facilities are requested or required, the Member will pay installation costs. The Member will pay for costs of repairs, labor, and materials for damage due to vandalism. The Member will also pay for all costs of relocating any light. This rate applies only to Cooperative owned lighting. Only LED lamps are available. Cooperative Area Lighting. Upon failure of any currently owned Cooperative owned lighting Area Lighting, such lighting Lighting will be replaced by the Cooperative with LED lighting, and applicable charges willmay apply.

ine Member will pay for costs of repairs including labor and materials for damage to Cooperative Area Lighting
resulting from an act of vandalism as determined by the Cooperative. The Member will be responsible for any
costs of repairs including labor and materials for damage to existing facilities owned by the Member.
Member Requests
Relocate. The Member will pay for all costs, including labor and materials for the relocation of any
Cooperative Area Lighting and necessary facilities in accordance with the Line Extension Tariff (Section 300).
<u>Change Out.</u> Any Member requesting ato change from an existing, working lampout functional
Cooperative Area Lighting to LED lighting will pay \$250 for the first light and \$180 for each additional light the
net book value of the existing Cooperative Area Lighting plus labor costs of change out requested by the same
Member at the same basic location and at the same time.
Thisas determined by the Cooperative. Following the change out, the Cooperative will adjust the Member's
account(s) to reflect the appropriate rate applies only to Cooperative owned lighting. Member owned street
lighting is billed under 100.3 Small Power Rate.
Removal. Only applies to Cooperative Area Lighting installed on Member-owned facilities. Any
Member requesting the removal of Cooperative Area Lighting must provide notice in writing to the Cooperative
The Member will be responsible for paying the net book value of the existing Cooperative Area Lighting plus
labor costs of removal as determined by the Cooperative and any costs for disposal of the Cooperative Area
Lighting. Upon removal, the Member will be responsible for any costs associated with furnishing of new lamps
or lighting fixtures including labor and installation and maintenance and repair. Following the removal, the
Cooperative will adjust the Member's account(s) to reflect the appropriate rate.
Purchase. Only applies to Cooperative Area Lighting installed on Member-owned facilities. Any
Member requesting the purchase of Cooperative Area Lighting must provide notice in writing to the
Cooperative. The Member will be responsible for paying the net book value of the existing Cooperative Area

<u>Base Power Cost:</u> The per kWh cost incurred to cover the cost of power and cost incurred in connection with the development and management of the Cooperative's power supply. <u>Qualifying members may choose either Flat Rate Power Cost or Time of Use Rate Power Cost as defined in the Power Cost Recovery (PCR) Tariff.</u>

<u>Flat Rate:</u> The per kWh Flat Rate Power Cost for power supply charges stated in the Power Cost Recovery (PCR) Tariff (Section 100.13).

<u>Power Cost Adjustment</u>: The charge per kWh for changes in power supply charges relative to the Base Power Cost and calculated in accordance with the Power Cost Recovery (PCR) Tariff.

The monthly bill shall be the sum of the above charges plus any applicable fees.
