Organization	Grant Award	Project Description
Hoover Valley Volunteer Fire and Emergency Services	\$23,296	Purchase new portable (handheld) communication radios and accessories
Cassie Volunteer Fire Department and EMS	\$19,643	Purchase a fire rescue boat
Friends of Oakalla Public Library	\$4,590	Replace 10 single-pane windows installed in the 1960s with double-pane windows
Round Mountain Volunteer Fire Department	\$20,050	Purchase five communication radios to be installed in the firetrucks
Gem of the Hills	\$22,500	Community Center: remodel existing restrooms to bring up to current ADA standards
