




Annual Line Extension Comparison






Line Extensions by District (1,360)








Meter Totals






SAIFI Trending (YTD)







- Interconnection inspections grew to 30% higher than in 2018, the team also managed to meet platinum level KPI goals for Energy Audits completed.





Facilities Update

Office	Activities
Canyon Lake	The front-office was closed mid-November for construction of security improvements. Expecting to re-open by early March.
Cedar Park	The Anderson Mill access road appraisal has been submitted to TxDOT for review, waiting on TxDOT for next steps.
Johnson City	Minor renovations complete to consolidate Engineering at Haley Road Buildings A and B.
Leander	Multiple parties have shown interested in land parcels and those leads will continue to be discussed. Conceptual site plans are being developed for an administrative building.
Marble Falls (Former district office)	Property is being prepared for use by the Safety and Training department.
Oak Hill	The warehouse construction was finished in July and final permits continue to be processed.

163 Request for Quotes (RFQ) issued - this process requests competitive quotations from vendors to ensure best value for PEC

24,378 Requisition lines processed - this process requires procurement policy compliance review, agreement verification, funding verification, and account coding verification

7,248 Purchase orders processed - this process converts requisitions to purchase orders and authorizes services or the order of goods

\$199,535,013 Value of requisitions processed for materials and services

2020 Way Ahead

Technology enhancements – implement eSourcing platform, vendor portal, and contract management portal

Financial reporting – spend, savings, cycle time, and purchase order activity

Staff training – training plan with the Institute for Supply Management (certified professional in supply management)

Policy – implement streamlined competitive procurements and update thresholds





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
