2020 By the Numbers

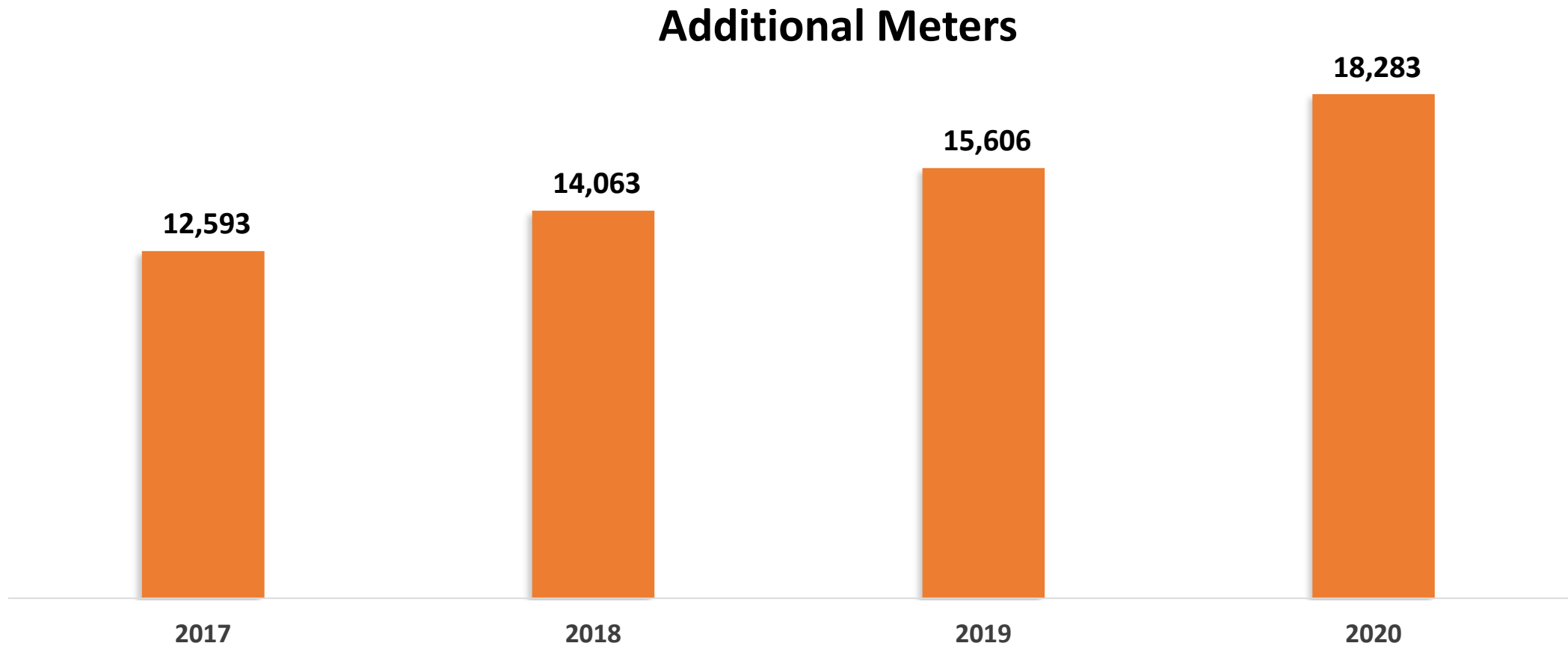
- **34,254** new member applications processed

As of December 31, 2020



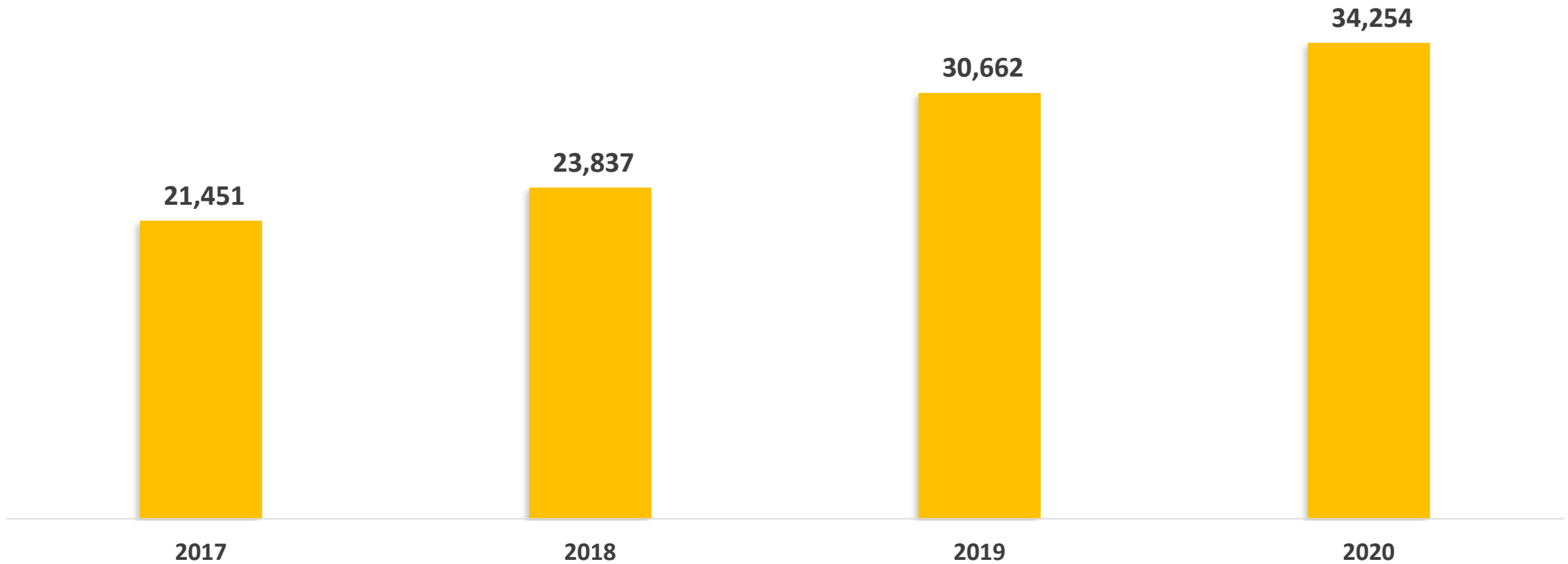
Rapidly Increasing Growth

2020: 346,089 meters

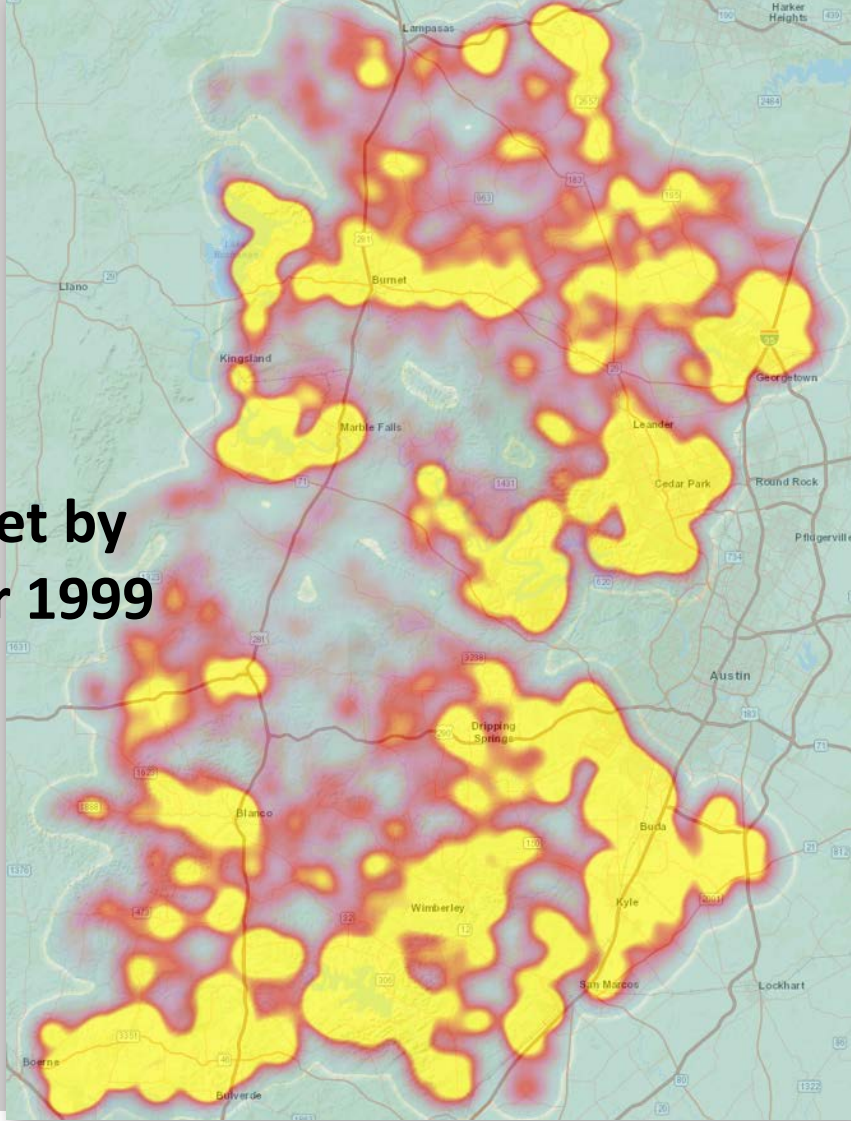

Member Applications Processed

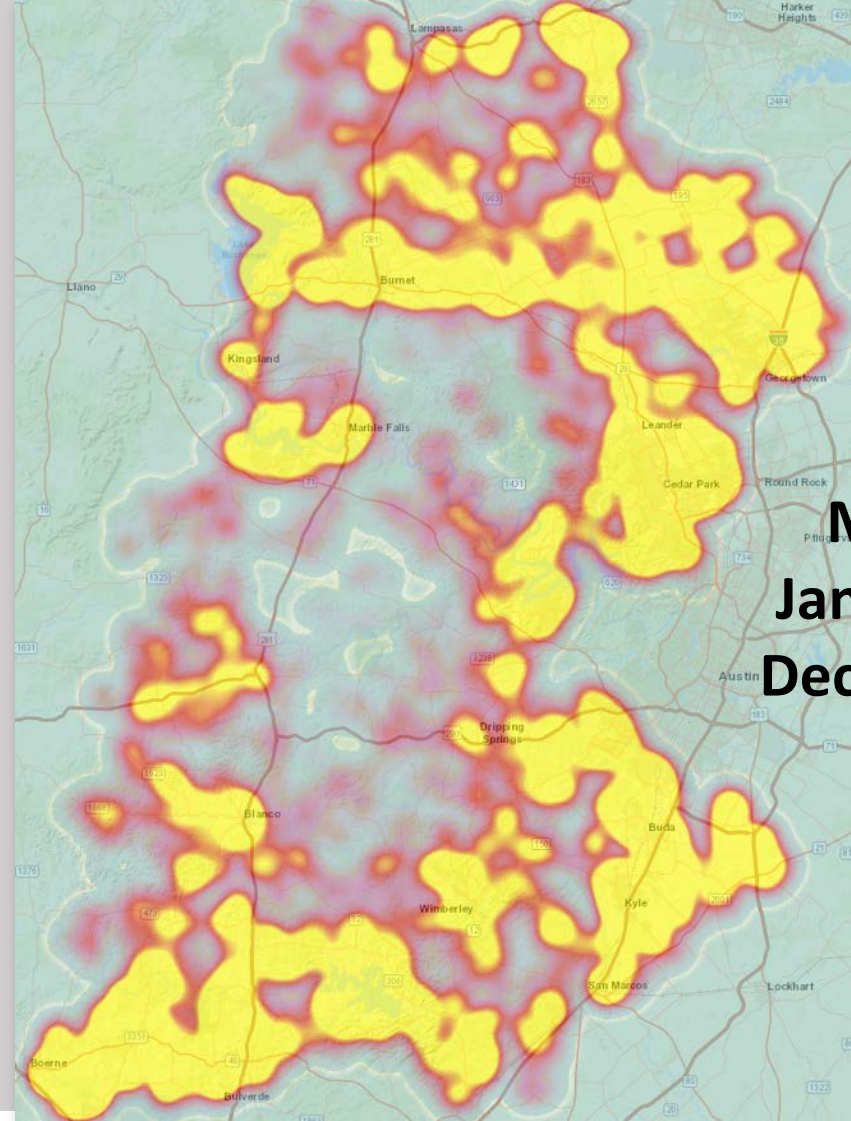


High Growth Continues

December 1999**

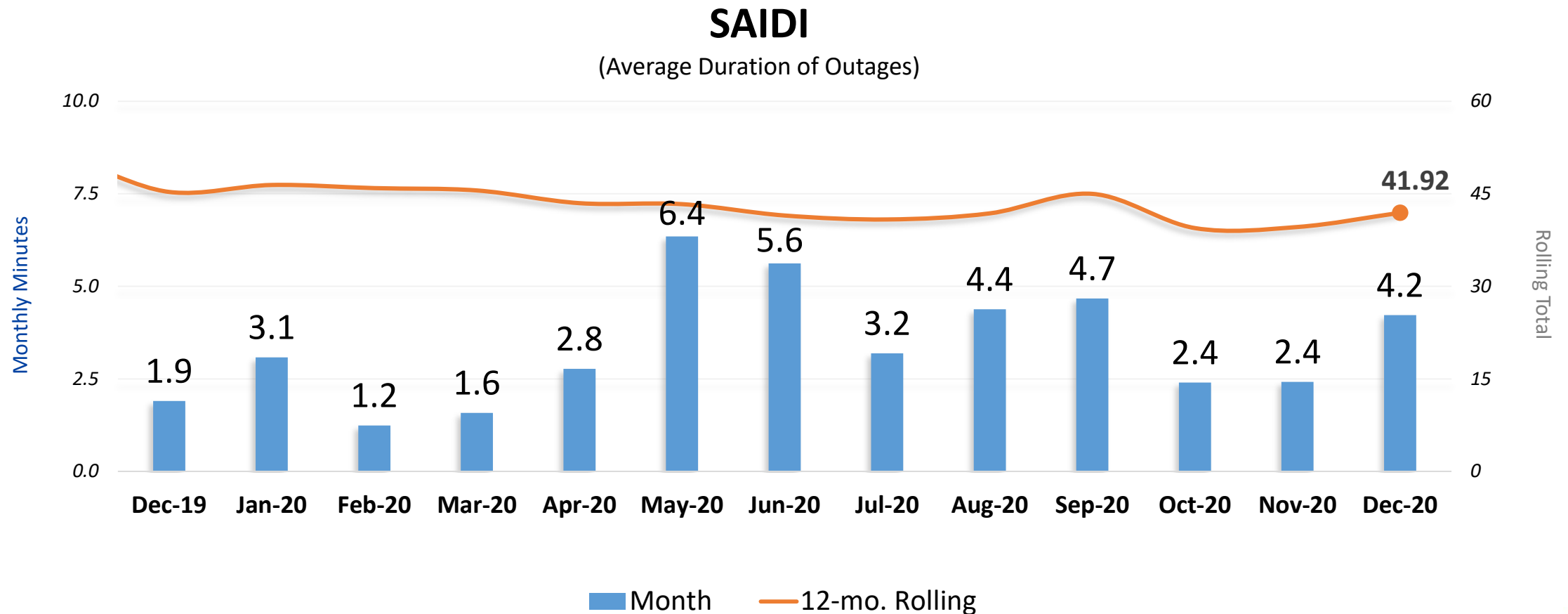


**Meters set

December 2020**



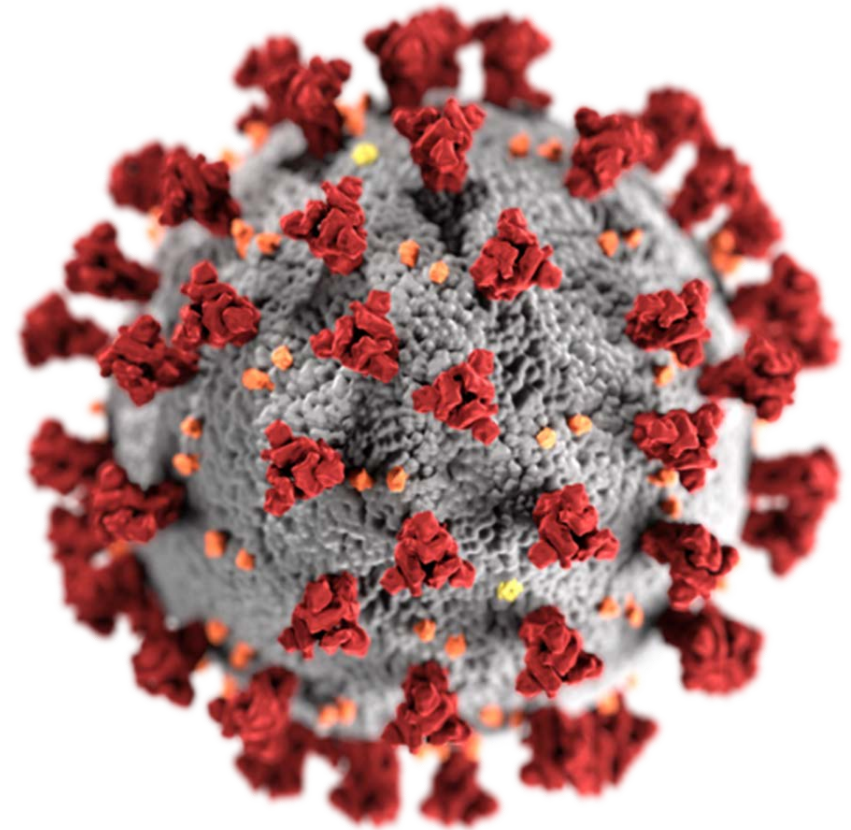
2020 SAIDI Record

COVID-19 Update: Lobby Closures

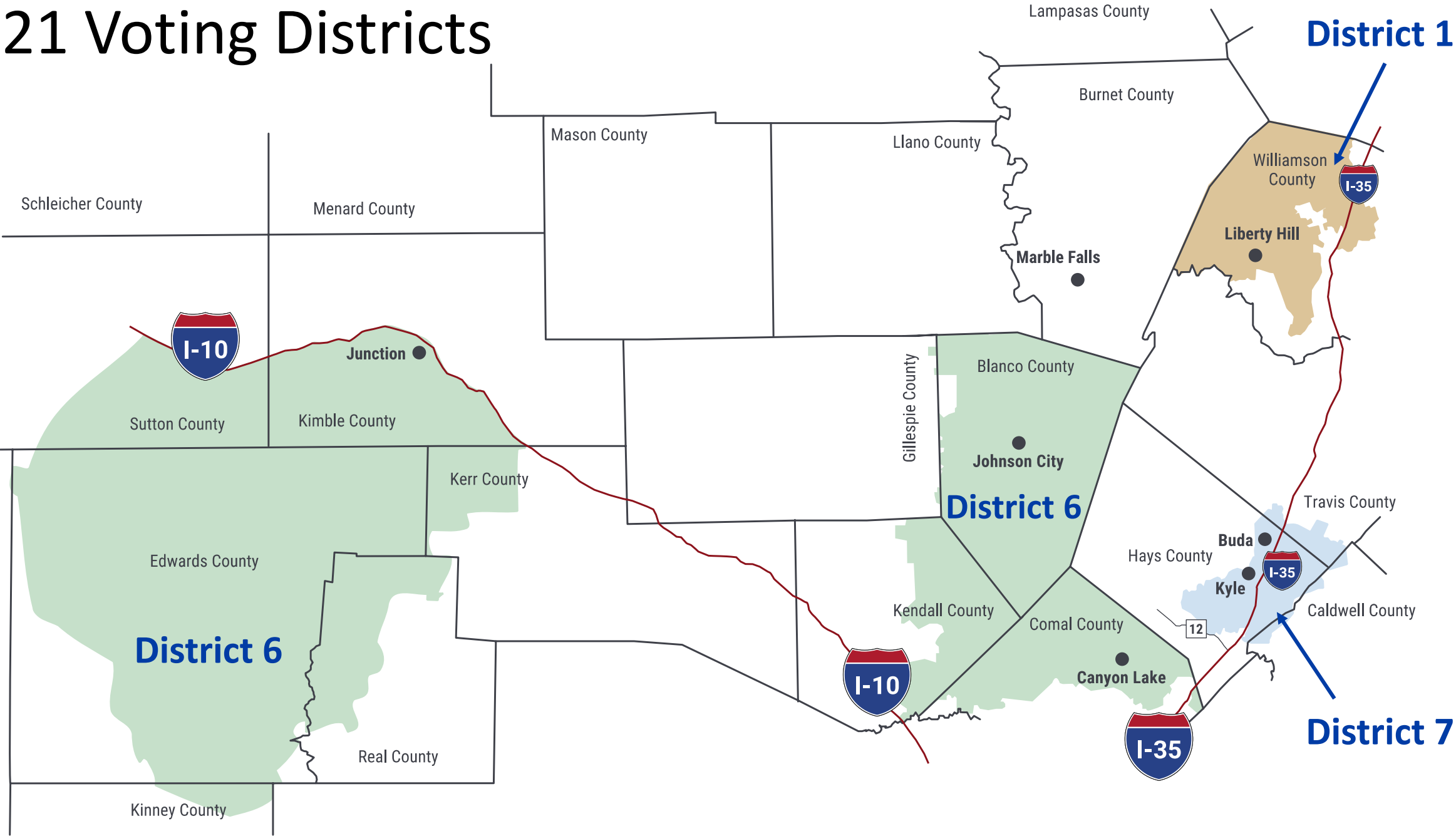
- Oak Hill office closed December 28, per Travis County guidelines

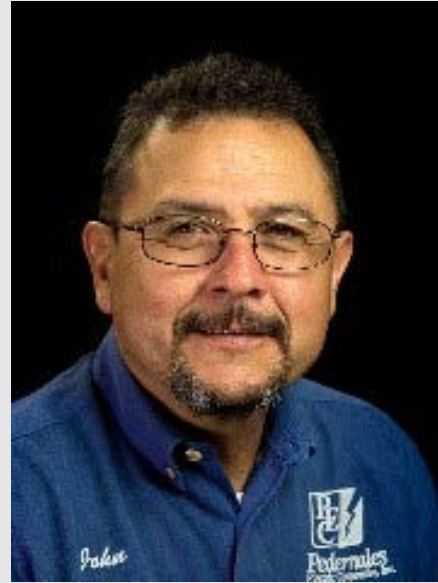

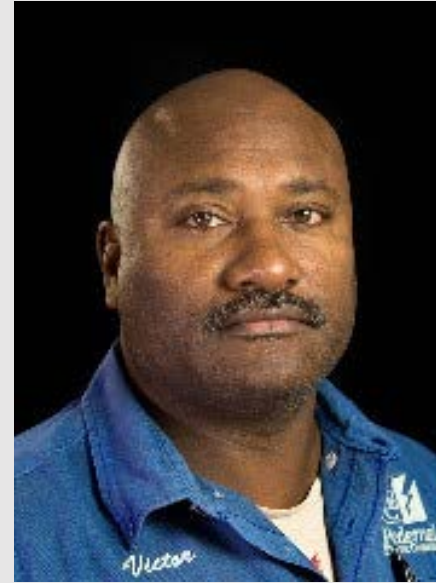

Member Appreciation

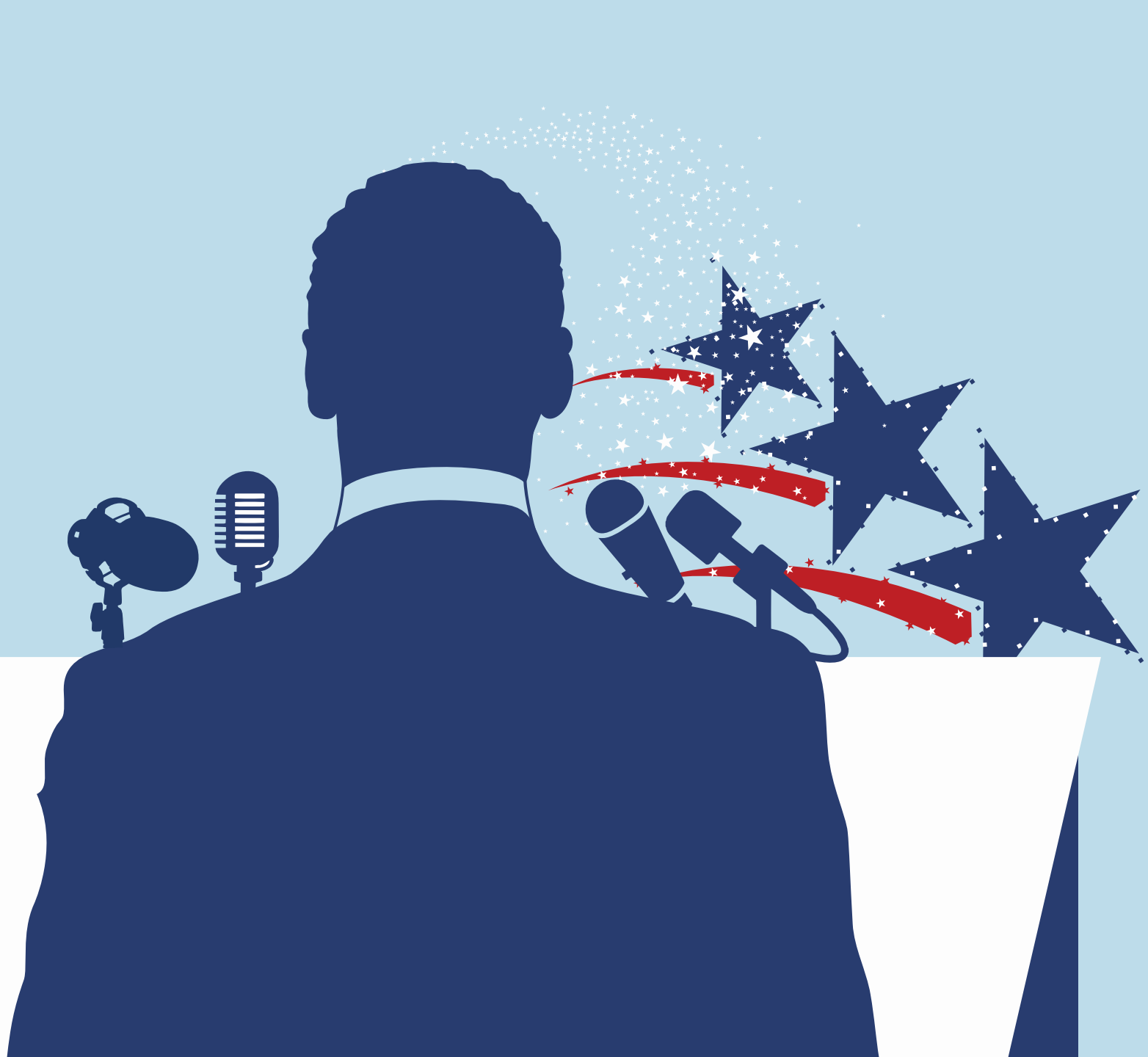
