Pursuant to the Board's Policy on Policies, the Board routinely reviews all Board policies as part of its policy management. Under the Board's approved review schedule, the Board may now consider review of The Ethics and Compliance Reporting Policy. The purpose of this policy is to support a culture of ethical behavior and adherence to established standards of conduct. The policy provides a mechanism for reporting suspected violations of these standards.
